# Road Resurfacing / Kerb Renewal

The annual road program ensures that the road infrastructure such as asphalt pavement, kerb and gutter is upgraded as required and maintained to an acceptable level. Selection of roads is on a priority basis using an asset management system.

# **Footpaths**

Council's footpath program consists of new and replacement footpath construction.

#### **Traffic Facilities**

Traffic facilities are devices built in the road reserve to slow traffic and improve safety for drivers and pedestrians. They include flat top road humps, pedestrian refuges and traffic islands

Badajoz Road, North Ryde (Pedestrian refuge)

#### **Neighbourhood and Town Centre Upgrades**

# **Sportsfield Renewals and Upgrades**

Sportsfields identified as high priority in Council's asset register are scheduled for renewal works which include regrading and levelling of the playing surfaces, installation of automatic irrigation systems and subsoil drainage

Meadowbank Netball Courts – asphalt base and final 'plexipave' laid.

#### Pending works (April - May 2013)

Marsfield Park – grading, turfing and irrigation complete. Synthetic cricket wicket to be completed April 2013

ELS Hall Park - Drainage and irrigation works in field 2 and 3 to be completed April 2013

#### **Toilet Upgrades**

Toilet upgrades are undertaken to meet the needs of user of the facility and to improve building ventilation and security. The parks are utilized through summer and winter by local sporting groups on a regular basis as well as a number of casual users.
