LIVVI'S PLACE AT YAMBLE RESERVE – GRAND OPENING Sunday 3 February 2013, 10.00am – 2.00pm

Livvi's Place at Yamble Reserve, Quarry Road, Ryde - the first all-inclusive playground for children of all abilities in northern Sydney - will open on Sunday 3 February.

When the ribbon is cut hundreds of children will enter a magical place where they can play, learn and socialise.

Celebrations include an official ceremony, entertainment headed by Touched by Olivia Ambassador Jay Laga'aia, and a whole lot of fun and discovery.

Livvi's Place combines traditional play equipment with purpose built play and landscape elements, providing a safe, outdoor environment for children and carers. Themed play zones that stimulate, calm and provide sensory interest for children with physical, intellectual and emotional disabilities are a feature of the design. They include a modified flying fox, swing style hammock, a maze path with sensory art and plantings.

City of Ryde Mayor, Clr Ivan Petch, said: "This inspiring project, right in the heart of Ryde, has been two and a half years in the planning and really shows that great things can be achieved when all levels of government in partnership with the whole community pull together to work for a common cause."

The project was born when the City of Ryde joined forces with the not-for-profit Touched by Olivia Foundation, with an initial pledge of \$375,000 (later increased to \$725,000) to kick-start the visionary plan.

The Council pledge also included the land at Yamble Reserve, special needs playground design (with AECOM), amenities block, footpaths, parking and picnic facilities, community consultation and project management.

A successful community fundraising campaign saw over \$150,000 flow in and both the State and Federal governments contributed grants totalling \$587,000 to the project.
