COMMUNITY CELEBRATES REFUGEE CONTRIBUTION

In 2013 the City of Ryde became a Refugee Welcome Zone and next members of the community are invited to celebrate the contribution refugees have made to our society with the sharing of food, stories and performances at the West Ryde Community Hall as part of World Refugee Week.

City of Ryde Community and Culture Manager Baharak Sahebekhtiari said: "This is a celebration of our community's diversity and a chance to hear about refugee stories and accomplishments, and to find out about local services and partnerships available through the Community Migrant Resource Centre."

The Council is partnering with the Community Migrant Resource Centre to highlight the contribution refugees have brought to the local community at this special free event that includes food and refreshments.
