**NSW ELECTORAL COMMISSION DETERMINES NOT TO PROSECUTE RYDE COUNCILLORS  
FOLLOWING ICAC INVESTIGATION**

The NSW Electoral Commission advised today that it would not proceed with prosecutions against former Ryde Councillors Ivan Petch and Victor Tagg and current Councillors Justin Li, Terrence Perram and Jeffrey Salvestro-Martin for possible breaches of the Election Funding, Expenditure and Disclosure Act following ICAC Investigation, Operation Cavill.

The NSW Electoral Commission cited “insufficient admissible evidence” for its decision.
