MAYOR LAXALE ELECTED NSROC VICE PRESIDENT

City of Ryde Mayor Clr Jerome Laxale is the new NSROC Vice President. He is the first Labor councillor to be elected to the position.

Lane Cove Mayor Pam Palmer was elected President and the co-Vice President is Clr Scott Bennison, also of Lane Cove council. The election was held on Thursday 9 November, 2017.

Clr Laxale said he was delighted to have been supported by fellow councillors from the region. "I look forward to working with President Pam Palmer (Lane Cove), and co-Vice President Scott Bennison (Lane Cove) to strengthen NSROC and getting the best value for ratepayers across our region."
