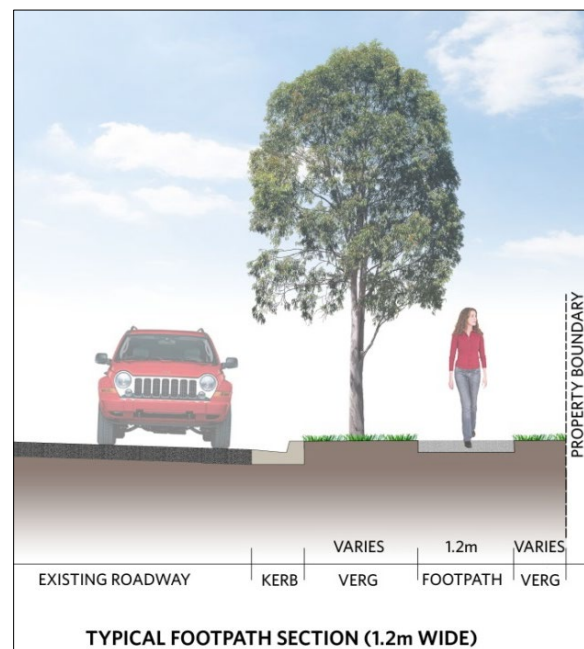
## Amiens Street Footpath Construction (Clare Street - Delmar Parade)

### Dear resident

We would like to inform you of the upcoming construction works to be undertaken on the north side of Amiens Street between Clare Street and Delmar Parade, Gladesville.

The City Of Ryde is committed to creating safe and accessible paths for the community as part of Council's four year delivery plan for new infrastructure.

This work will involve construction of a new footpath and provision of kerb ramps at intersections. New stairs and handrail will also be provided to assist with the descent to Delmar Parade.



### Timing Of Works

#### Start of construction

Construction is expected to commence on 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2020.

#### Completion of construction

Construction is expected to be completed within two weeks of works commencing, weather permitting.

### Changed Conditions

Street accessibility and traffic will be altered during construction hours. In the case where access to your property will be affected, you will be contacted by Council's contractor, Kelbon Concrete and Paving.
