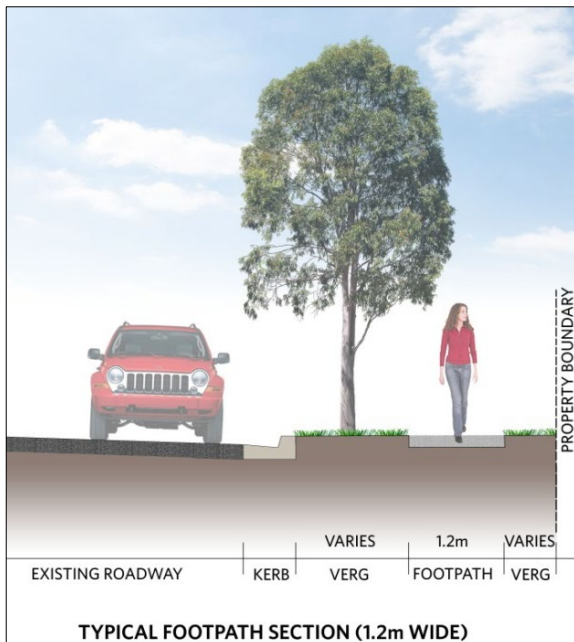
Mahon Street Footpath (Goodwin Street – Anzac Avenue)

We would like to inform you of the upcoming construction works to be undertaken on Mahon Street, West Ryde, between Goodwin Street and Anzac Avenue.

The City Of Ryde is committed to creating safe and accessible paths for the community as part of Council's four year delivery plan for new infrastructure.

This work will involve construction of a new footpath on the west side of Mahon Street, removal of redundant kerb ramp at the Anzac Avenue end and returfing of disturbed areas.

Timing Of Works

Start of construction

Construction is expected to start on the week of **23 September 2019**

Completion of construction

Construction is expected to be completed within 1 week of works commencing, weather permitting.

Changed Conditions

The majority of works will be completed between 7:00am to 5:00pm. Street accessibility and traffic will be altered during construction hours. In the case where access to your property will be affected, you will be contacted by Council's Contractor, QMC.
