Stormwater Drainage Upgrade

Mars Lane, Gladesville

Dear resident

The City of Ryde is committed to the delivery and maintenance of high quality infrastructure and facilities. As part of this commitment, there will be stormwater drainage works in Mars Lane, Gladesville (see map on reverse side).

The work is part of Council's four year delivery plan for new infrastructure and includes provision of a longitudinal earth mound and improvements to the existing rock lined channel at the downstream end.

This work is to direct overland flows along Mars Lane and reduce the risk of them entering properties on the lower side of Mars Lane fronting Kennedy Street.

Timing of works

Construction is expected to commence in **late 2020** and last approximately six weeks, weather permitting.

Further notification will occur to confirm the commencement date two to three weeks prior to works commencing.
