Kissing Point Park boat ramp upgrade



Dear resident

Council's Foreshore Program aims to manage and maintain foreshore infrastructure and assets to ensure that they remain safe, are sustainable in the long term and provide a satisfactory level of service for the community.

In early 2020, we asked for your feedback on an upgrade of the Kissing Point Park Boat Ramp. Following the feedback received, we developed a concept design for the upgrade and provided a community update with the design in late 2020. We are now pleased to advise that works are due to commence.

The works include:

- Widening of the boat ramp to allow for two simultaneous users
- Car park layout improvements
- · Additional seating and shelters
- New fish cleaning table
- Boat washdown facilities

Future works:

 Upgrade of the amenities building in its existing location

The delivery of these boat ramp improvements has been made possible through support from Transport for NSW via the NSW Boating Now Program.

Timing of works

Start of construction

Construction is expected to commence in late July 2021.

Completion of construction

Construction is expected to be completed in December 2021, weather permitting.

Works will primarily be undertaken Monday to Friday between 7.00am and 6.00pm with some works scheduled outside these hours to coincide with tidal and marine operational requirements.

Changed Conditions

The boat ramp will be closed for the duration of the works with the jetty to remain accessible at times during the construction. Other alternative boat ramp locations are available at Melrose Park, Rhodes, Silverwater, Concord and Drummoyne.

Some car parking spaces will be unavailable to allow for the construction site compound.

Where required, Traffic Control will be in place to manage traffic and pedestrian movements safely.
