WATERLOO PARK, MARSFIELD PLAYGROUND UPGRADE

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The City of Ryde is committed to ensuring that all families have access to safe, accessible and high-quality parks.

As part of our Playground Renewal Program, we will be upgrading the playground in Waterloo Park.

What will the works include?

The new playground will include installation of an interactive water feature, table tennis, additional play equipment, new range of pavements, seating and landscaping works.

Pedestrian access will be altered for the duration of the works.

Timing of Works

Construction start: Tuesday 11 April 2023

Expected Completion: Mid June 2023,
weather permitting

Works will primarily be undertaken from Monday to Friday between 7.00am – 4.00pm and occasionally on Saturdays between 8.00am – 1.00pm.

Changed Conditions

The existing playground will remain available for use during construction with fencing to barricade the works, however one of the existing picnic shelters will be unavailable.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.
