As part of this commitment, Council will be upgrading the pedestrian lights at the following pedestrian crossings:

- 10 Chatham Road, West Ryde
- 60 Badajoz Road, Ryde
- 22 Lincoln Street, Eastwood
- 126 Buffalo Road, Ryde
- 31 Oxford Street, Gladesville
- 85 Epping Road, Macquarie Park
- 7 Bay Drive, Meadowbank
- 2 Parsonage Street, Meadowbank

What will the work involve at 10 Chatham Road, West Ryde?

- Supply and install new pedestrian crossing floodlight including required underground work.

When will the work take place at 10 Chatham Road, West Ryde?

The night work is expected to occur in the week of Monday 8 January 2024, between 7.00pm and 5.00am, weather permitting.

Changed Conditions

Traffic control will be in place to manage traffic and pedestrian movement safely throughout the work. There may be some noise disturbance at times while this work is completed, however it is expected to be minimal due to the nature of the work.
