#### 4. Matters Arising:

#### Racism. It stops with me - barbecue

The first of the above Racism - It stops with me, community barbecues will be held on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2015 between 11am and 1.00pm at the Ryde Multicultural Centre – Lions Park West Ryde.

Ryde Multicultural Centre's undertaking as a campaign partner for the Australian Human Rights Commission's "Racism. It stops with me" campaign will be signed at the barbecue.

## Arresting Vulnerability

Gunjan Tripathi has carried out research which has found that despite the generally high incomes of most residents of Ryde, that there are pockets of the community where people experience food insecurity and fail to eat regularly. There has been an increase in the number of people seeking relief vouchers from charity groups. Reasons for this include mortgage stress, unemployment etc.

It is noted that funding for emergency relief services is moving from traditional providers to more broad based organisations with call centre arrangements.

It is feared that the local knowledge of related support services may be lost.

# Racism stops with me – Unified Ryde video update and planning

The Unified Ryde video was created with assistance from the Salvation Army, Macquarie University, Ryde residents, community leaders, has been completed and is being edited.

The video was possible due to a grant provided by Council to the Salvation Army which worked in conjunction with Macquarie University.

Lots of students in marketing, psychology etc. TEDx Macquarie University were involved.

The video will be shown at the TEDx Macquarie University event to be held on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2015.
