



# App makes it easier to dive on into the carpool

CARPOOLING may not be a new concept but a new app is aiming to make it much more accessible.

Earlier this month the Co-Hop carpooling app was launched by non-profit organisation Connect, which focuses on finding easier transport, traffic and parking solutions in the Macquarie Park and North Ryde business area.

In the first week more than 50 people had signed up from some of the major organisations, according to Connect's general manager Rebecca Lehman. "It's very exciting and we're hoping once people come back from the school holidays and congestion rises again that people will consider a travelbased behavioural change." Novartis Pharmaceuticals HR manager Karen Hawes and a colleague, who both live on the northern beaches, have been carpooling for almost 18 months.

They meet at a set point along their journey and have found multiple benefits.

"The carpark situation here changed so carpooling was one of the options we immediately thought of because public transport was not really possible," Ms Hawes said.

"We talk about work along the way, which is handy, but it has also helped with bad habits. I used to stay in the office until 9pm but now I have to think about that – it's all about compromise."

Connect is a non-profit organisation based in Macquarie Park focused on transport solutions. General manager Rebecca Lehman said it had recently launched two initiatives to ease the congestion – spreading business hours and a carpooling app.

"We want to spread the peak hour to make the roads and carparks more manageable," Ms Lehman said. "If we can take just five to seven per cent of cars off the road at peak periods, that gives the same lift that we experience during school holidays."


