

- Macquarie University Priority Precinct was announced 24 September 2015
 - Redevelopment of Ivanhoe Estate


Commercial Car Parking Rates

- In 2015 Bitizios Consulting undertook a review of commercial car parking rates in Macquarie Park
- Goal is to position Macquarie Park to better respond to traffic pressures and future growth
- The Bitzios report was considered by Council 22 September 2015
- Planning Proposal is being prepared to be exhibited in early 2016 for public comment

The Challenge


- Macquarie Park has a 75% car modal share... not sustainable
- Macquarie Park is expected to double in size by 2031; current car parking rates not sustainable
- Public transport networks need to support future growth ...NWRL a critical infrastructure coming online 2018

Recommendations

- Existing allocation of car parking spaces will remain
- Transition to new rates ...link to improvements in transport infrastructure
- Proposed new rates
 - 1 to 60 sqm and 1 to 100sqm ...moving from the existing three tier system to a two tier system



Continue to support Transport Management Association (Connect Macquarie Park + North Ryde)	On going funding






