	Jeff Peers and Michelle Chiu provided an update on its Development Application for the Macquarie Shopping Centre.	The information was noted.	
	 Key information includes: Dec 2015 AMPCapital provided its Stage 1 Concept DA for Macquarie Centre which seeks approval for: A new commercial/retail podium towards Herring Road to replace the existing structure Building envelopes for four mixed use towers fronting Herring Road Maximum additional gross floor area (GFA) of 148,000sqm The creation of a 'Station Plaza' between the train station and the shopping centre Basement and rooftop car parking envelopes to accommodate a maximum of 2,175 additional car spaces New vehicle and pedestrian access points. Mr Peers confirmed that this DA does not seek approval for demolition or construction works. Such approvals will be sought via subsequent detailed development applications following completion of this DA. Mr Peers also stated that discussions with the State Government regarding the unsolicited proposal to deliver a new bus interchange were progressing well. The two projects would support the agreed vision of AMPCapital, MQU and Council for a Town Centre located within the Macquarie Station Precinct.

	Andrew Parker – Chair of Connect announced that Rebecca Lehman will not be continuing in the role as GM of Connect. Mr Parker acknowledged Ms Lehman's skills, dedication and passion during her three year role as General Manager.	The information was noted	
	Mr Parker then provided an update on research undertaken by Connect regarding transport within the precinct. Of particular concern was that speeds on Lane Cove Road during peak periods can drop to as low as 15kph.		
	He highlighted the Connect Program CoHop which matches ride sharing buddies. To date over 600 drivers have joined. This initiative has the potential to significantly reduce single vehicle trips.		
	Currently Connect is undertaking a bus shelter campaign to highlight the benefits of public transport.
