








Shrimptons Creek Upgrade 2017






Elouera Reserve Upgrade 2018






Elouera Reserve – birds eye view




Lane Cove Road Lighting Upgrade



Project – 'Deferred'
Lighting design has been developed for Lane Cove Rd (Waterloo to Talavera Rds)
However, Council was concerned that the timing to deliver the project prior to the rail shutdown was too tight and is 'on hold'

Short Term Car Parking Trial

28 sites across Lyon Park, Byfield, Giffnock and Eden Park Drive 6 months trial – March to September 2017 Report to Council late 2017



Next Steps in car parking

Council considered the report and endorsed the following recommendations ...

- retain the 28 trial 2P ticket spaces on a permanent basis; and
- undertake a further trial of twenty 2P ticket spaces in Coolinga Street and Giffnock Avenue, to compensate the loss of on-street parking along Waterloo Road due to bus-priority measures.

Develop a long-term Parking Plan for Macquarie Park, to include:

- locations for short-term pay parking;
- locations for taxi parking;
- locations to expand on-street car share spaces;
- locations for bus layover areas, and
- "trigger points" to gradually undertake changes.


