2.2	Lunar New Year Festival Update

	 Two meetings have already been conducted, first with the members and the second with Mr McCarthy. 	
	Proposed third meeting this coming Friday.	
	 Dates of celebration are confirmed for Saturday 1 February. There will be the lion dance to visit the shops in Eastwood together with the God of fortune to bring them luck – this will be held on the on the second day of the Lunar New Year. 	
	 The following Sunday, the 9th, a cooking competition will be held, as usual. Last year's winner will be a judge. 	
	 A cooking competition sponsor has been secured. 	
	 The theme of the competition will be 'how to make good noodles'. Noodles will be provided to the contestants to try it at home first. 	
	- There will be three judges.	
	- The main event celebration will be held on 15 February.	
	 As usual, sponsorship packages will be sent out to all potential sponsors, and some sponsors have already secured as gold and jade sponsors. 	
	This Friday the sub-committee will have more information to provide to the committee regarding its progress.	
	Mr Fu advised that the main events include the dragon which consists of	

	18 people and a high pole lion dance.	
	 The high pole lion dance is on YouTube, where potential sponsors can view it. 	
	 CIr Etmekdjian confirmed that he won't be able to attend the cooking competition. 	
2.3	Cinema in the Plaza	
	 Ms Long advised that after the last meeting the decision went into doing a cinema screening "Nightmare before Christmas" including also a few dance groups. 	
	 A lot of the supplies were sourced after Halloween. 	
	 There will also be a creepy Christmas puppet making stand.

	 Looking at going down to local retailers to offer seating to generate more patronage for the cinemas. 	
	 The screen will be near the kiosk towards the fountains. 	
	 Activities will be held behind the screen so that it can be packed down while the movie is screening. 	
	 Guests will be encouraged to bring low seating. 	
	 Looking at possibly having characters dressing up. 	
	- The Mayor has been asked to come as Dracula.	
2.4	Foreign Film Cinema Eastwood Plaza	
	The foreign film cinema was booked to be part of the foreign film festival, however two weeks ago Mr McCarthy received a call from the festival organisers and one of the proposed movies had not received approval. Since it was two weeks out, the decision was made to cancel the event.
