	Possible ways of implementing this program were discussed as consensus could not be reached as to whether the program should focus on a competition or workshop on public speaking.	Noted		
	There was concern that not conducting workshops would limit the participants to those who are competent public speakers.			
	A quote is to be obtained for running a workshop.			
	If the cost of this is prohibitive, there may not be the opportunity to hold a workshop.			
	It was noted that the Premiers Public Speaking competition has a cross section of entrants not all of whom are experienced speakers. It attracts many speakers who have no public speaking skills.			
	It was suggested that if funding is limited, a decision may need to be made as to whether a workshop or competition should be supported.			
	A future meeting is to be arranged at which Andrew will provide further information.
