**EASTWOOD'S KOREATOWN TO BOOST LOCAL ECONOMY**

The City of Ryde has once again shown it is committed to supporting local businesses with the decision to establish Koreatown along Rowe Street East in Eastwood.

While Council won't be renaming any suburbs or streets, we will be partnering with the Eastwood business community, local residents and other stakeholders to establish a working party that will identify signage, monuments and other public works that will create an appropriately identifiable Koreatown precinct in Rowe Street East.

Rowe Street East has long been recognised as the largest Korean cultural business precinct in Sydney, and the establishment of Koreatown will not only recognise this but also help reinvigorate the area which has been severely hampered by the COVID-19 pandemic over the past two years.

This has been done successfully in places like Leichardt, with the establishment of the now booming 'Little Italy'. I think Ryde can do even better.

I would like to thank Clr Daniel Han for bringing the motion to Council, with the support of Clr Charles Song and all other councillors who unanimously supported this important initiative.

Come and join us in celebration of our 1000 Books Before School early literacy program with Ryde Library staff, Macca the Alpaca and friends!

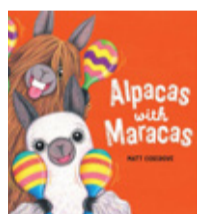
