

GRANNY SMITH HISTORY

Maria Ann 'Granny' Smith was a local. She and her husband Thomas had a farm in Eastwood, near the Field of Mars. It was here, in 1868, that she 'accidentally' grew the first Granny Smith apples, when some crab apple seeds sprouted in the compost heap, and she recognised them as a new kind of seedling.

Today these tangy green apples are grown, eaten and enjoyed throughout the world. Granny Smith would have been astonished! This year we celebrate 38 years of the Granny Smith Festival!

GETTING THERE

The Festival attracts a large crowd which can mean parking is limited. Leave the car at home and catch a bus, train or the Shop Ryder free shuttle service.

The best spot to view the parade is on Rowe Street so follow the pink parade route on the map and grab your spot early.

Finalist performances start from 2.30pm at the K-Town Madang Stage.


