Capital Works Update September 2012

Footpaths

Council's footpath program consists of new and replacement footpath construction.

Road resurfacing / Kerb renewal

The annual road program ensures that the road infrastructure is upgraded as required and maintained to an acceptable level. It also ensures kerb and gutters are maintained to an acceptable level and repaired when required. Selection of roads is on a priority basis using an asset management system.

Charity Creek Cascades is an interconnected series of parks approximately 0.48 hectares in size. These parks are located in Ryde, between Top Ryde City and West Ryde station.

The section between Bowden Street and Griffiths Avenue has been completed with a shared user path and kerb ramps installed. Delays were due to service adjustment by Telstra.

Pending works

'Livvi's Place' Yamble Reserve Inclusive Playground. The project brief is to design and construct an all abilities playground. The project is in partnership with the Touched By Olivia Foundation. Demolition is complete and earthworks are underway. Works to follow are civil works and playground installation with the contractor working to a completion date of late December 2012.
