4.	<p><b>Minor Works Update</b></p> <p><b>4.10 and 4.11 of minor works action list – The steel barriers located at Hawkes pathway between Beswick Avenue and Parklands Road should have been removed as they are non-complying.</b></p> <p>Council has painted the existing non complying bollards. Bike Committee was advised in previous meeting that the barriers were installed to stop cars and motorbikes utilising path as a shortcut and Bike Committee has agreed not to replace with bollards.</p> <p><b>Path from Robinson Street to Forest Road in the vicinity of Ryde Secondary College.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- There are a number of tree roots on the path making travel dangerous for cyclists and pedestrians.</li> <li>- The bollard near the bridge should be removed. It is low and dangerous.</li> <li>- The erosion in the vicinity of the bridge has made the path unrideable.</li> <li>- The path should be sealed.</li> <li>- The kerb ramp however is badly eroded.</li> <li>- Consideration should be given to creating a shared path which could be used by school students if it continued to the school.</li> <li>- The distance from the bridge to the kerb ramp is approx. 56m.</li> </ul> <p>Lachlans Line</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The direction signs at Wicks and Waterloo Road are not in the standard COR format.</li> </ul>	<p>Noted</p> <p>To be included in Bike Plan update, expected in 2018.
